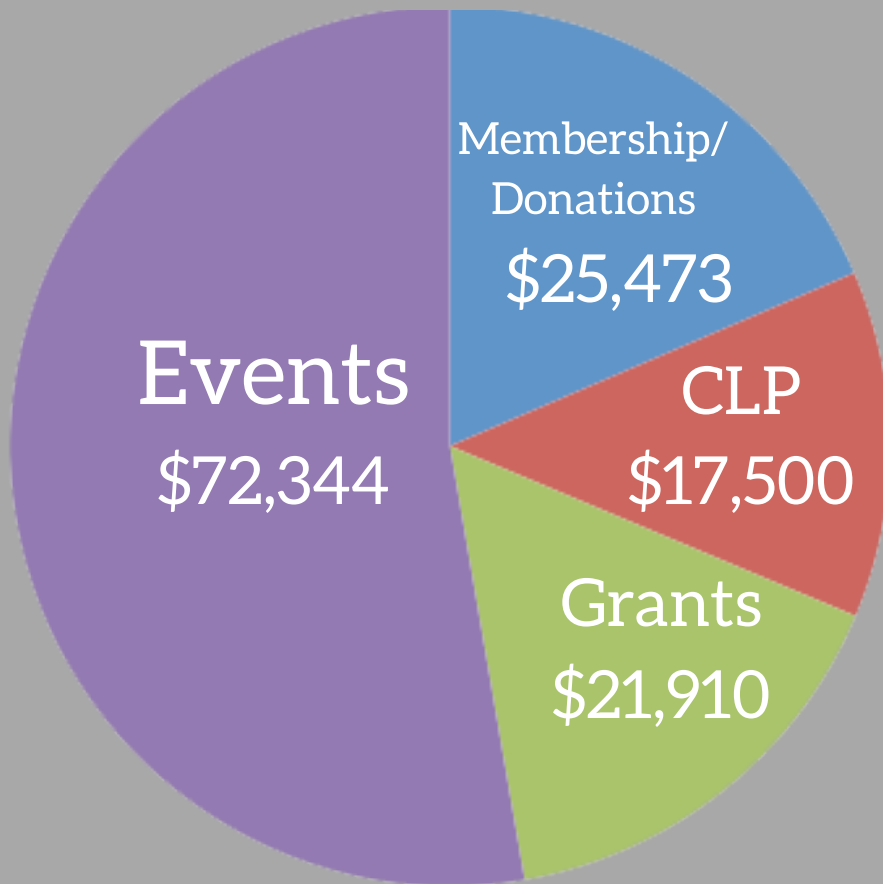

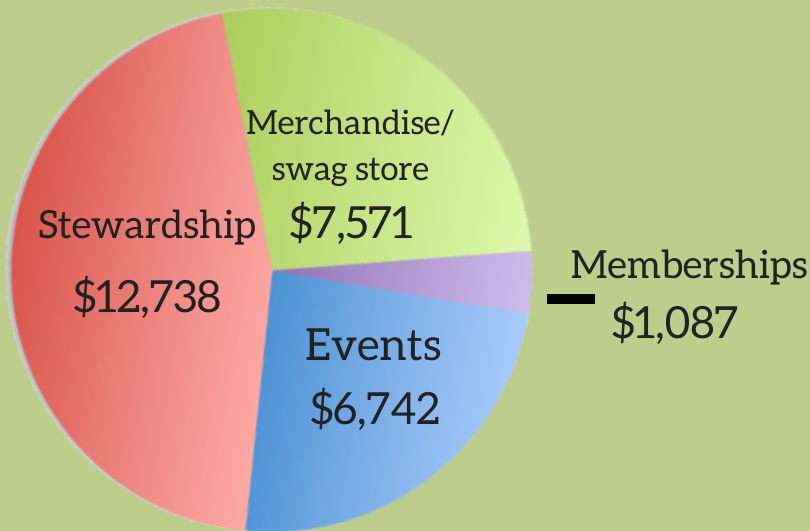

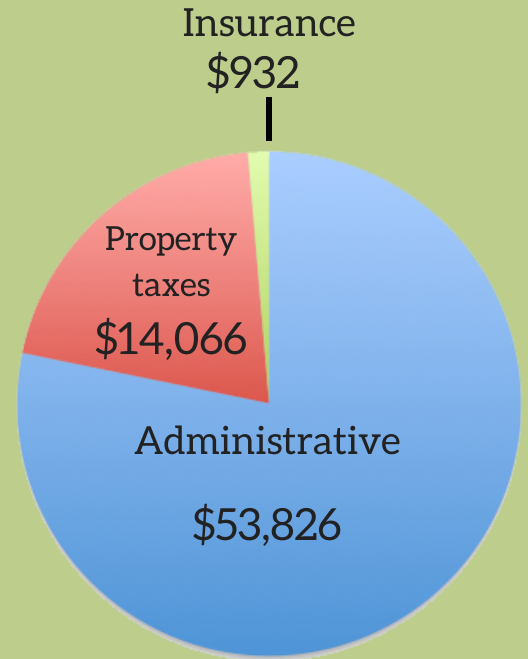
Total Revenue - \$137,227

2016 was a very big year for the SCC! We made our largest climbing area purchase to date and passed the 1,000 member mark. More than 50% of our revenue is earmarked for paying off the Denny Cove loan, \$35,000 is earmarked for various crags and projects, and \$33,000 goes in our general/admin fund
