## Staircase to Climbers Parking

#### **Golden Arches Wall**

1. Gruss Project (Closed Project) - Far left side of short overhanging gold wall

## The Portal (anything left of Joe's ladder)

- 1. That Was It 5.7 Left of two left facing dihedrals 25 feet left of actual (Tewahade/McBride)
- 2. This Is It 5.7 Right of two left facing dihedrals (Tewahade/McBride)
- 3. Gruss Project (Closed Project) Steep arete feature just left of portal
- 4. For Whom the Bell Trolls (Closed Project) Steeper climbing starting right of portal turns the arete and continues on vertical face (Murphy)
- 5. Bonnette Project (Closed Project) Steep roof to vertical face to the right of portal
- 6. The Last Cruxade 5.8 Anchors only. Long 100+ foot adventure route. Starts on steep left face boulder problem up to first cam placement ~20ft. From there stay left on jugs to pull onto a stance then up slab to a big ledge. From ledge go up a featured crack system with good gear to anchors. (McBride)

1. Bone Voyage 5.8+ - Improbable looking start on some loose blocks, pulls onto a very nice face. (McBride/Dellaringa)

# Main Staircase (Between domes 1 and 2)

#### The Backyard

 Natty Pablo 12c - First route on the shady wall at the bottom of the stone staircase (Meeks) 2. Money Trees (closed project) - seam and face just right of 'Natty Pablo' (Murphy)

#### The Pond Shop

- 1. McBride Project (closed project) Anchors only. Rock apron comes all the way to the ground, follows line of weakness through the roof
- 2. Pouring Project (closed project) Stick clip first two chains from atop the ledge, use belay re-direct bolt for rope management. Boulder out low roof and climb brilliant rock through several cruxes to the top of the cliff
- 3. Miller/Swafford Project (closed project) Obvious roof crack. Anchors on top, gear route.
- 4. Pond Stars 12d Left facing black rock corner to tall headwall (Meeks)
- 5. Meeks Project (closed project) Just right of 'Pond Stars'
- 6. Elongated 13a/b White tiers to tall headwall (Meeks)
- 7. Pondsy Scheme 12d/13a Shares opening boulder with 'James Pond' and breaks left through tiers. Stick clip first chain draw and use sling on belayers bolt for rope management. Kneepad strongly recommended. (Robinson)
- 8. James Pond 13a Arete to techy face, dark right facing wall. Shares first bolt with 'Pondsy Scheme' and uses belayer bolt for rope management. Kneepad strongly recommended. (Miller)
- 9. Miller Project (closed project) Tiered route near right facing corner. Corner and left wall are off.
- 10. Pouring Project (closed project) Flat roof boulder to techy face.
- 11. Pouring Project (closed project) Hard boulder intro to shady face.

#### **Early Bird Wall**

- 1. Closing Time 10d Climb through low roof jugs and up the beautiful face sequences. (Gentry)
- 2. Pondering Soul 12b Obvious Arete. Easier climbing leads to a few tough moves to gain the arete then pumpy climbing to fixed anchor. (Averbeck)
- 3. Dawn Patrol 11d Low crux below roof. Pull onto face above and enjoy sustained face climbing. (Bonnette)
- 4. Morning Wood 12c Low crux below roof leads to easier face climbing. (Beard)
- 5. Early Bird Special 11b Roof pull through fixed chain to easier face climbing above. (Bonnette)
- 6. The Weekender 12b Boulder out low roof to stance followed by techy sustained crimp climbing. (Kovatch)
- 7. Wandering And Pondering 12a Low roof followed by immediate crux. FA'd without stemming on side wall. Just right of corner. (von Gremp)
- 8. Thriller 10d Obvious offwidth between 'Wander and Pondering' and 'The Waker'. Sent the day M. Jackson died. Bolted anchors. (Averbeck)
- 9. The Waker 12b Boulder through initial pillar and encounter a difficult overhung face section followed by easier arete outro. (Robinson)
- 10. Pondtaneous Combustion 10a Tall and moderate with two roof pulls and a fixed chain towards the top. (Robinson)

11. Pouring Project (closed project) - Steep start leads to boulder problem on great rock in dihedral. Finish on thin technical face above.

#### 5.10 Wall

1. Hoosier Daddy 10d - Moderate face climbing on far left side of the wall. Scramble up to belay ledge and stick clip first bolt. (Kovatch)

## The Bakery

- 1. Biscuit Pimp 11b Start on ledge then climb spine feature. Ode to Dondra's ex-husband. (Webber)
- 2. Webber Project (closed project) Anchors only
- 3. Pond Cake 12c Rides the arete above the ledge. Fully equipped. (Bonnette)
- 4. Flake N' Bake 12b Starts left of horizontal roof above ledge just right on 'Pond Cake'. (Stefurak)
- 5. Boulangerie (closed project) Right side of low roof then up face (Murphy)

#### The Den

- 1. The Moderator 5.7 Short dark right facing wall. Start on a low arete climb into a seam and jugs. (Gentry)
- 2. Lost Feather Endeavor 5.9 Just right of 'The Moderator'. (Gentry)
- 3. Too Late Chicago 5.8 (Traditional) Short crack on left side of block. Rap off tree. (verena Draper)
- 4. RP4 Detour 5.9 Start 10ft left of CCB. Step up and left to gain a right leaning system. Reach over small roof and place an RP#4 then continue up and right to finish on CCB anchor. (McBride)
- 5. Christmas Car Bomb 5.7 Follow obvious flake (McBride)
- 6. Before the Burn 5.9 Short face left of a crack system up a fun face. (Gentry)
- 7. Getting The Band Back Together 5.9 (Traditional) Dihedral with awkward start that leads to easier climbing. Anchors on arete. (Verena Draper)
- 8. Feel the Burn 10b Quality sport line through orange rock and several features. (Gentry)
- 9. Hal Garner Project (closed project) Bolted line up thin orange face.
- 10. Unknown Crack (Traditional) Anchors at top.
- 11. Apostrophe 13a/b Face climb between cracks. (Heddins)
- 12. Unknown Crack (Traditional) Anchors at top.
- 13. Hoser 12c Vert wall, face and crack. (Murphy)
- 14. Takeoff Speed 12c Boulder through bottom to stance. Make a huge move then continue upwards through crimps and slots. (Bonnette)
- 15. Webber Project (closed project) Just right of corner
- 16. Phone Keys Wallet 11b Boulder to first ledge then continue to boulder atop cliff. (Bonnette)

- 17. Bad Santa 5.9 (Traditional) Follow broken crack system through headwall. Anchors at top. (Verena Draper)
- 18. Irresponsible 11d Direct line up the face, does not use crack. (von Gremp)

## Spooky Ledge

- 1. Old Glory 11c Obvious arete where ledge begins just before the handline. (Averbeck)
- 2. Crystal Light 12a Just to the right of the arete on a perfectly vertical face. (Bonnette)
- 3. Mojo 5.8 (Traditional) Hand crack just above the beginning of the hand-line. Anchors at top. (McBride/Tewahade)
- 4. Ball of Fire 5.9 (Traditional) Wider crack to the right of 'Mojo' that follows the thin crack above the ledge. (verena Draper)
- 5. The Masterpiece 5.9 Start in left facing dihedral step up and on to face. Right facing slab wall. (McBride/Dellaringa)
- 6. Pond Fiction 5.9 Just right of 'The MasterPiece'. (McBride)
- 7. Blue Ghost Lander 5.9 Right trending line up beautiful face. (McBride)
- 8. Pond Sauce 11b Slab to steep just above step down. (Webber)
- 9. Bean Skin Tooth 12c/d Just right of corner above step down on south facing wall.
- 10. Paden Project (closed project) Just right of 'Bean Skin Tooth'

## **Tiger Wall**

- 1. Tiger Snake 11c Left most route on Tiger Wall. Starts left of crack and crosses over halfway up the wall. Stick clip first two bolts. (Webber)
- 2. TR anchors fair game to bolt or climb trad or whatever
- 3. Suavamente 12a Starts off the big slanted boulder at some chicken heads for hands. (Heddins)
- 4. Robinson Project (closed project) shares start with 'Tiger Toes'
- 5. Tiger Toes 12a Opening roof and lipturn boulder gives way to a broken, wandering, shallow crack feature. (Robinson)
- 6. Waka/Jawaka 13a Climbs through low horizontal roof on good holds then straight up orange face. (Heddins)
- 7. Miller Project (closed project) Just right of 'Waka/Jawaka'
- 8. Hot Rats 12c Steep start to black streak. Stick clip chain at the lip of the roof. (Heddins)
- 9. House Cats 12d Righter black streak (Hal Garner)
- 10. Hal Garner project (closed project) Variation off of 'House Cats'
- 11. Webber Project (closed project) Left side of lighter colored wall to the right of the black rock.
- 12. Banana Boat 13b Low horizontal roof then up multicolored, gently overhanging face. Boulder through two sequences to a pumpy finish. (Murphy)
- 13. The Best Route On Mars 12a Orange face with pockets, huecos, and underclings on left facing wall. (Miller)
- 14. The Gnartian 12c Steep underbelly to overhanging headwall. Just right of 'Best Route On Mars'. (Miller/Wise)
- 15. Shark Box 13b Steep white prow to tiger shark head wall. (Miller)
- 16. Paden Project (closed project) Just right on 'Shark Box'.

- 17. Bongo Fury 11b Left most route on super featured wall to the right of prow. A must do. (Heddins)
- 18. M.M. Project (closed project) Just right of 'Bongo Fury'
- 19. Chunky Chicken 11a Super featured gently overhanging. (Webber)
- 20. Ashley Garner Project (closed project)

#### **Castle Wall**

- 1. Miller project (closed project) anchors only
- 2. Fisher project anchors only
- 3. King Of The Castle 13a Through bulge to castle jugs at the top. (Paden)

#### Serfdom Wall

- 1. McDaniel Project (closed project) tallest portion of wall
- 2. Robinson Project (closed project) Just right of McDaniel project

## King's Courtyard

- Rocky Road 5.6 First route right of short weakness in cliff line. (Madeline/Liam McBride)
- 2. McBride Project (closed project) just right of 'Rock Road'
- 3. McBride Project (closed project) Starts in dark rock up orange ridge
- 4. McBride Project (closed project) 25ft right of last route

## **Right Side**

- 1. McBride 5.8 Next arete ~40ft left of 'The Cruise'. Step through weakness then follow arete to top.
- 2. The Cruise 10c Scramble up to a stance with a tree to belay at chain anchor. Start leftward traverse out to join arete then follow arete to top. (McBride/Dellaringa)
- 3. The Scenic Cruise 5.9 Pull a small roof onto a beautiful low angle easy arete. May want a cam or two getting to first bolt. (McBride/Dellaringa)
- 4. 18 and Up 5.8 V1 boulder to 5.7 face (Matt/Liam McBride/Sarver)
- 5. 21 and Over 5.9 V2 boulder to 5.8 beauty (McBride/Sarver)
- 6. All Ages Show 5.9 Wall to the left. Starts at the low weakness near a tree, up past roof on right. Crux after roof on thin friction to reachy clip. (McBride/Sarver)
- 7. Silliman project (closed project) wall left of stone door
- 8. Silliman project (closed project) wall left of stone door
- Welcome to Pond Creek 10a Obvious arete climbers left of stone door. (McBride/Kovatch)
- 10. Unknown Two random bolts near top of cliff right of arete

# Stone Door @ The Point

#### The Roost

 Captain Falcon 13a - Scramble up though keyhole cave and start on top of boulder. (Murphy)

- 2. Bonnette Project (closed project) Steep perfectly overhanging feature climber's right of stone door
- 3. Heddins Project (closed project) Right variation of Bonnette project
- 4. Paganini 12d Left route on the northeast face of the point rock. Use the belay redirect bolt in low rock for rope management. (Heddins)
- 5. Webber Project (closed project) Just right of 'Paganini'

## Out Of Bounds - Cliffline climbers right of the Point

- 1. von Gremp Project (closed project) anchors in black rock
- 2. My Anna Ponda 11c Stick clip 2nd. Red rock choss start to crack feature. (Von Gremp)
- 3. Pocket Starfish 11c Steep boulder start to bonus climbing (Stefurak)
- 4. Crank Tank 12b Hard pulls starting in alcove with 2 chains. (Stefurak)
- 5. Ponderbox 11d Blank stemming leads to nice slot jugs and a slopey finish. (Stefurak)

### **Wonderboy Block**

- 1. Baby Sass 10b Furthest left up the hill on the left facing wall (Heddins)
- 2. Beezleboss 11b Next route to the right (Heddins)
- 3. Young Nasty Man 12b Starts on Wonderboy and goes left (Heddins)
- 4. Wonderboy 12b Steep start up the middle of a nice white chunk (Murphy)
